

TSCA (Toxic Substances Control Act)

Dear Customer,

thank you for your inquiry regarding TSCA (Toxic Substances Control Act).

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has adopted the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) section 6(h) rule, which addresses five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) substances, effective March 8, 2021. This regulation prohibits the use of the 5 substances listed below.

This concerns the 5 following substances:

- PIP (3:1) – Phenol, Isopropylated Phosphate (3:1) (CAS-Nr.: 68937-41-7)
- DecaBDE – Decabromodiphenyl ether (CAS-Nr.: 1163-19-5)
- HCBd – Hexachlorobutadiene (CAS-Nr.: 87-68-3)
- PCTP – Pentachlorothiophenol (CAS-Nr.: 133-49-3)
- TTBP – 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (CAS-Nr.: 732-26-3)
